Option C: Service Project

Description: Complete a service project in an AgrAbility related area (see qualifications below) and submit a service story and pictures documenting the project. Projects should have a clear goal(s) and work plan outline.

For a project idea to qualify, it must meet the following criteria:

- Serve a farmer, farm family, agriculture worker, or agricultural community
- Serve an individual or a group with a disability or long-term health condition
- Provide a lasting impact (Example: Build a raised bed versus pull weeds)
- Project may serve a current AgrAbility client, but that is not required

Impact 50%	<p>Was the project helpful to a person or people with a disability or long-term health condition?</p> <p>Did it serve a farmer, farm family, ag worker, ag, community, individual, or group?</p> <p>Did it provide a lasting impact?</p>		
Story & Pictures 25%	<p>Does the story and photos effectively capture the goal and work plan of the project?</p> <p>Is it neat and well written?</p> <p>Does the story use person first language? (<i>Person First Language: to tell what a person HAS, not what a person IS; Example: a "person with autism"</i>)</p> <p>Were the photos high quality and appropriate? (<i>A minimum of 5 photos is required.</i>)</p> <p>Is proper credit given to groups or individuals involved?</p>		
Safety & Accessibility 10%	<p>Were safety considerations or accessibility concerns addressed by the project? <i>Provide description.</i></p>		
Completeness of Project 10%	<p>Was the project completed in the time and under the conditions suggested in the project work plan?</p>		
Timeliness of Entry 5%	<p>Was the entry sent to AgrAbility PA by March 21, 2017?</p>
